Vetting and judges briefing: As specified above. Bitches only without proof of desexing. All dogs must pass through check point by close of vetting. No dogs should be in the vetting area unless required to be vetted. All elements are one single trial and therefore Rule 8.1.3 applies.

Catalogue: From Top Dog Events and Scent Work SA Facebook page 1 day prior to trial

Judging Order: Saturday November 22nd – all classes concurrently. Sunday November 23rd – Ultimate before Ultimate NFC. Judging may commence with judges and stewards' dogs.

Entry amendments: Competitors should only enter those elements that they are eligible to enter. Ultimate NFC is open to any competitor currently eligible to compete in one Masters element. Refunds for balloted entrants will only be processed once it is confirmed no further balloted entrants will be re-entered in the trial.

Hot Weather Rules: If required the Dogs SA hot weather rules for Scent Work will be applied. If cancelled due to the Hot Weather, Extenuating Circumstances. or the Extreme Weather and Safety Rules, no entry fees will be refunded. If the start time is delayed to 7:00pm, the lower entry limits specified above will be applied for balloting.

Sashes and Prizes: Ribbon to all qualifiers. Clear Dog Treats Prize for 1st place. Other prizes and trophies as donated. A single presentation will be conducted as soon as practical at the conclusion of judging of each class.

Notes: It is not appropriate to train in Scent Work at the trial location prior to trial date. For this trial a period of 14 days prior is to be observed unless training is approved affiliate training. Spectator areas for this trial As per ANKC Scent Work Rule 11.1.1, a spectator area may be available the Ultimate element only.

Welcome

Thank you for your entries and to the judges and stewards for helping to make this Scent Work Trial of the Gundog Club of SA happen. The following catalogue has general information about the trial and also some pages which are specific to each day of the trial. Please ensure that you read all the general information and also the specific information for the day/s that you are entered.

Please remember that everyone involved in this trial is a volunteer so please be respectful of all those giving up their time to provide you with this opportunity.

Competitor numbers and check-in

Competitors will need to download and print their own competitor numbers for all dogs they have entered prior to attending check-in. Competitors will need to take their numbers to the Check-in Stewards to be checked in.

No numbers = No check-in

Numbers can be downloaded directly from Top Dog Events: go to “My Entries” and select the relevant trial. On the right hand side will be a “Download Numbers” button OR go to the “Trial Page” for the event and in the top right hand corner will be a “Download Numbers” button. If you don’t have access to a printer then the numbers can be written clearly on paper that can then be worn the same as a printed exhibitor number.

While competitors will print their own numbers all dogs are still required to be checked-in on each day of the trial that they are entered. The dog must be present at the trial location to be checked-in.

For bitches with written proof of desexing, the relevant paperwork can be shown at the time of check-in. No proof is required for associate register bitches.

Under no circumstances are there to be dogs present in the check-in line.

Competitors are reminded that once checked in, the competitor number must be displayed in such a way it is clearly visible to the assembly stewards and other search area officials.

Competitor check in and vetting will occur in the main carpark area near the Dogs SA office. Please see the trial maps below for the specific location of check in. All competitors are required to check in within the check in time specified.

Only dogs that require to be vetted should be within the check-in area during the check in time.

Vetting

Vetting is required for all entire bitches and any bitches without **written** proof of desexing. Competitors will be required to vet their own dog under observation of the vetting steward. Where a tattoo is being used as evidence of desexing the tattoo must be clearly visible to the steward. If there is any doubt the same vetting process as that for an entire bitch will be used.

Any competitor that requires more than one bitch to be vetted must have an individual handler for each bitch to be vetted or bring dogs to the vetting steward one at a time. It is not the responsibility of the vetting steward to hold dogs for competitors while they vet another dogs.

Only dogs that require vetting are to be in the vetting line.

Exhibitors **MUST** bring their competitor numbers for all bitches that require vetting on that day with them to the vetting steward. Once your dog has been cleared, the vetting steward will stamp your numbers which can then be taken to the check-in desk for the dog to be checked-in.

Dogs that have been vetted are not considered to have been checked in. They have been vetted only. Once vetted, dogs should be returned to vehicles and the stamped competitor numbers only taken to the check-in desk.

Any competitor that requires their dog to be vetted should ensure that they are vetted in enough time to return to the check-in desk with their stamped numbers prior to the close of check-in.

Competitor briefing

Briefing for both days will occur in the same area as check-in of the trial unless communicated otherwise.

No dogs should be present at the competitor briefing.

Search areas and trial precinct

All competitors should ensure that they are familiar with the areas indicated on the following pages that can be accessed on the day of the trial and those area that should not be accessed unless under direction of a trial official.

Please ensure that you pay attention to areas where dogs can be toileted and those area's that should be kept clear unless moving to a search area.

Running of searches

Competitors will be called according to the catalogue order with all classes running concurrently. All competitors should regularly check the number boards located in the staging area for their respective search and ensure that they are nearby when they expect to be called to ensure that you are ready to be marshalled for your search. Those handlers running multiple dogs should have been ordered to avoid clashes.

Any competitor absent after 3 calls will be marked absent and not be allowed to participate in the search.



Trial Logistics


Parking and Access

On the day of the trial some areas have been designated as either No Parking, or parking for Trial Officials Only. Competitors are free to park in any other parking area within the Dogs SA grounds outside of these areas.



Search Areas and Toilets

The search areas for the trial on Saturday are as indicated below to assist competitors with planning where they will park. All competitors are required to use the Kerry Loo toilets for the trial. The toilets that are part of the main administration building, and the toilets at the Kings Room are not available to competitors at any time. Marshalling for all searches will occur in the same location at check-in as indicated on the map below.



Movement Around the Grounds

Dogs should remain on lead at all times with the off lead area out of bounds to competitors. Competitors are free to move around the grounds and toilet their dog as they wish but are asked to keep those areas that will be used for competitor access to search areas clear at all time. This means not just clear of dogs but also of people.

Trial Logistics

For Ultimate and Ultimate – Not for Competitions, competitors can park in any area within the red lines below and must remain in this area at all times unless accessing the toilets. Competitor toilets are located in the main administration building and are accessed near the canteen. Please ask a trial official for directions if you are not familiar with their location. The grassed area in front of the main administration building can be used for toileting dogs but competitors should not go towards the end of the main building to avoid line of sight concerns with the search area.

Anyone attending that is not a competitor and will not have dogs with them can park in the main parking area, or at the rear of the administration building near the off lead area. There may be others onsite during the running of Ultimate so please be respectful of other members at all times. If you are concerned that any individual connected with the trial is in an area they shouldn't be please raise this concern with the SACA Rep or another trial official.
