Vetting time: 5.00 pm to 5.40 pm

This trial is conducted under the rules of the Canine Control Council (Queensland). A copy of the rules is available for perusal from the Trial Manager, Jane-Louise Conlon.

The trial precincts include the Club grounds and car parks adjacent to the grounds.

No barking or unsociable dogs are to be left unattended within the trial precincts.

Entry to and egress from the grounds and the adjacent car parks are to be by the main gate. Please do not cut across the grounds. Vehicular entry onto the grounds is only available to judges, committee members and stewards.

An exclusion zone applies to all rings, including that closest to the carpark, and beyond the wooden fencing on the perimeters of the grounds.

Bitches in season are not permitted within the trial precincts. All entire bitches on the ground must be inspected before entering the trial area and dogs must not leave the trial precincts without prior permission from the Trial Manager. The Trial Manager may direct that any dog be inspected.

The entry details as printed in this catalogue will be used on qualifying certificates. Please check that your catalogue entry is correct and let us know before the trial starts if any changes are needed.

Competitor numbers

Competitor numbers will be available for collection at registration. Competitors will have a different number in each Test.

Classes, judges and entries

Tests 1 and 2 will run concurrently. Running order in each trial is as per the catalogue order.

If you have more than one dog and a potential clash, please liaise with the stewards in both rings. If you miss your turn according to catalogue order, you will run at the end of the relevant class.
