Venue Map

Our venue is small but perfect for Ultimate searches. To make sure you don't accidentally walk into view of the search area or overhear a competitor in your class calling alerts, please stay clear of the shaded area before your run.

If you want to move your vehicle closer after your run that's ok.

Toilets – are just inside the door of the main building. They will be accessible before, between and after classes are run. There are public toilets opposite Banjos and Liv Eat on the main road. If it's an emergency, let the assembly steward know and they will arrange for you to go between competitor runs. *Please do not take dogs into the toilets.*

Food We are close to the centre of Campbell Town where you can find Banjos, LIV EAT and other food providers in the main street.

Some important reminders:

This is **ULTIMATE** 😊

Make sure you have read and understand ANKC Scent Work Rules Section 28. Ultimate is not just more hides and a longer time. Some differences include:

- No 30 second warning. You may self time if you wish.
- More distractions and different kinds of distractions
- Any or all hides may be inaccessible
- Hides may be buried
- At the judge's discretion you may be able to run off-leash if you wish. *Be aware that the ground is not completely enclosed, there is a public park adjoining and **if you decide to run off-leash outdoors it is at your own risk.***

Don't visit or train at the site before the trial. We don't want to risk contamination, and we want respect the Associations generosity in allowing us to use this venue.

No dogs at the competitor briefing. Please keep your dog clear of the assembly area if you are not getting ready to run. This is a small trial and there is no rush – you should not need to get ready until the dog before you has gone to their run.

Warm up boxes –will be located outside the grounds for Ultimate and in the front assembly area for NFC dogs. Please do not go to the warmup boxes until the dog before you has gone to their run.

No dogs off lead in the trial grounds unless running in your class with the permission of the judge.

Don't talk about the search. Talking about a search before the class finishes can lead to disqualification.

Photography and video – don't share any video of dogs running until after that class has finished, and never share any photos or video of others without their permission.

Use your personal social media for good! Share information about a great day with your dog, celebrate success, laugh about things you didn't do so well. But if you have any problems or concerns at the trial, raise them on the day with the Trial Manager, TCA Rep or other responsible person so they can be addressed.

Be aware that any breach of the Dogs Tasmania Social Media Policy may lead to disciplinary action.
