Check-in, Vetting and Briefing: As outlined above. Bitches only without proof of de-sexing to be in vetting area. All dogs must pass through check point by close of vetting.

Entry Fees and Limits: Novice, Advanced, Excellent & Masters: \$17.50 per element; Ultimate: \$30.00 per Entry. Should entries be more than limit a ballot will be conducted. If required the ballot will be conducted via Zoom on Thursday July 9th at 6.30 pm.

Eligibility: Competitors should only enter those elements that they are eligible to enter. Refer to 6.1 Titling Classes and 6.2 Progression through titling classes of ANKC Scent Work Rules (6.2.2 & 6.2.3)

Catalogue: Available from Top Dog events

Entry amendments: Balloted entrants will be offered places back into the trial up until the catalogue is finalised. Refunds after close of entries will only be available for balloted entries that do not receive a place back into the trial and will be processed after the trial date.

Sashes and Prizes: Ribbons to all qualifiers and KONG prize for 1st place.

Entries: Online entries and payments via Top Dog Events (<https://www.topdogevents.com.au>). Paper Entries to: SW Trial Secretary, PO Box 631, Angaston SA 5353. Paper entries must be submitted on the official scent work entry form. Email entries not accepted due to online entries being available.

Catering: No catering will be available at venue.

Hot Weather Rule, Extreme Weather, or Extenuating Circumstance: If the forecast temperature at 10am from the bom.gov.au site (or app) two days prior to the trial is 30° celsius or above, or this trial is impacted by Extreme Weather or extenuating circumstances, this trial may be postponed, or cancelled, or have the commencement time amended. If required to postpone, cancel or amend the commencement time, there may be no refund of entry fees.

Welcome

Thank you for your entries and also to the judges and stewards for assisting with the running of this trial. Also thank you to those that have helped with the planning and organisation of this trial and with set-up and pack up for this trial. A big thank you to those that have volunteered vehicles for searches.

Please remember that everyone involved in this trial is a volunteer so please be respectful of all those giving up their time to provide you and your dogs with this opportunity.

Competitor check in, vetting and briefing

Competitor check-in and vetting will occur up near the main buildings as indicated on the trial map. *Only dogs that require to be vetted should be within the vetting area during the check-in time.*

Briefing will occur in the competitor parking area unless communicated otherwise. *No dogs should be present at the competitor briefing.*

Check-in, vetting, and briefing times are as specified on the schedule

Competitor numbers

Competitors will need to download and print their own competitor numbers for all dogs they have entered prior to attending check-in. Competitors will need to take their numbers to the Check-in Stewards to be checked in. Competitors with the *same dog* entered in AM and PM elements on the *same day* are only required to check in once. Dogs entered in *PM elements only* can only be checked in during the *PM check in time*.

No number = No check-in

Numbers can be downloaded directly from Top Dog Events: go to “My Entries” and select the relevant trial. On the right hand side will be a “Download Numbers” button OR go to the “Trial Page” for the event and in the top right hand corner will be a “Download Numbers” button. If you don’t have access to a printer then the numbers can be written clearly on paper that can then be worn the same as a printed exhibitor number.

While competitors will print their own numbers all dogs are still required to be checked-in on each evening of the trial. The dog must be present at the trial location to be checked-in.

For bitches with written proof of desexing, the relevant paperwork can be shown at the time of check-in. No proof is required for associate register bitches. *Under no circumstances are there to be dogs present in the check-in line.*

Competitors are reminded that once checked in, the competitor number must be displayed in such a way it is clearly visible to the assembly stewards and other search area officials. All competitors are required to check in within the check in time specified.

Vetting

Vetting is required for all entire bitches and any bitches without **written** proof of desexing. Competitors will be required to vet their own dog under observation of the vetting steward. Where a tattoo is being used as evidence of desexing the tattoo must be clearly visible to the steward. If there is any doubt the same vetting process as that for an entire bitch will be used.

Any competitor that requires more than one bitch to be vetted must have an individual handler for each bitch to be vetted or bring dogs to the vetting steward one at a time. It is not the responsibility of the vetting steward to hold dogs for competitors

while they vet another dogs. ***Only dogs that require vetting are to be in the vetting line.*** Exhibitors MUST bring their competitor numbers for all bitches that require vetting with them to the vetting steward. Once your dog has been cleared, the vetting steward will stamp your numbers which can then be taken to the check-in desk for the dog to be checked-in.

Dogs that have been vetted are not considered to have been checked in. They have been vetted only.

Once vetted, dogs should be returned to vehicles and the stamped competitor numbers only taken to the check-in desk.

Any competitor that requires their dog to be vetted should ensure that they are vetted in enough time to return to the check-in desk with their stamped numbers prior to the close of check-in.

Running of searches

Competitors will search according to the catalogue order as listed unless otherwise communicated at briefing. ***Trial officials may complete their searches first before remaining competitors begin to be called or may run out of catalogue order.*** All competitors should ensure that are ready when it is their turn to search. ***Any competitor absent after 3 calls from the judges steward without prior approval of the judge and trial manager will be marked absent and not be allowed to participate in the search.***

Trial precinct

All competitors should ensure that they are familiar with the areas indicated on the following pages that can be accessed on the evening of the trial, and those area that should not be accessed unless under direction of a trial official. Please remember that. ***Please following any signage and direction of officials carefully.***

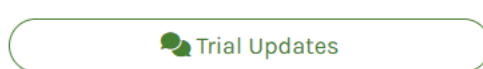

A reminder that competitors cannot discuss any details of their search. Comments like 'They searched awesome', 'We almost timed out', and 'She was so distracted' are not permitted according to rule 13.12 and can result in a disqualification.

Trial Logistics

All dogs must remain in the staging area unless they are required at vetting during the designated vetting time or required to be marshalling for their search.
